WHAT IS THE SCHEMA.ORG BLUEPRINTS MODULE?

The Schema.org Blueprints module takes a Schema.org-first approach to building content models and structured data in Drupal that is standardized, easy-to-understand, and maintainable.

WHY SCHEMA.ORG?

It feels inevitable that we need a universal, standardized, and collaborative content model.

Schema.org has a long history, with active usage, that makes it stand out as a content model.

WHY DRUPAL?

- Drupal's future is content.
- Content is only as good as its authoring tools.
- Machines work best with structured content.
- Drupal's super power is its modularity and extensibility.

- There is a patch (not a diff) to fix that

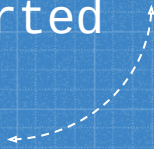
